11:00 am	Proceed to Mangala House for formal meal offering
11:15 am	Rice offering & chanting Anumodana
11:45 am	Sangha collect their food
12:00 pm	Shared meal for all
13:30 pm	Circumambulation of the Dhamma Hall with Chanting <small>Gathering and starting in Memorial Garden</small>
19:00pm	Vesakha Puja, Meditation & Dhamma talk
